About Us

Rooms & Communal areas

We aim to provide a home where people are looked after in a friendly and informal atmosphere. We encourage residents to bring their furniture to help create a homely feel within Albion Lodge. This helps people settle in during a time that we know can be quite stressful.

The rooms all have Wi-Fi, TV points, independent telephones, emergency call systems, and can be provided fully furnished if required. All bedrooms have en-suite facilities, majority with private bathrooms.

On the ground floor, there is a large welcoming reception with a pool table, lounge, library, hair salon, gym, and treatment room that offer comfortable areas where residents can watch TV, read books, and enjoy daily newspapers from our library. There is wheelchair access on all floors and two passenger lifts.



Meals

We recognise that food is an important part of the pleasure of daily life and that it

must be varied, wholesome and provide a balanced diet. All our meals are prepared in house by our cook and the team using fresh ingredients. There are three meals a day with the addition of morning coffee and afternoon tea with homemade cakes. We welcome residents own suggestions about what they enjoy and always provide personalised, flexible menus. Naturally, we are able to cater for residents with particular dietary requirements and we are able to assist residents who require support.



Facilities & Activities

We provide many services for residents on-site. These include chiropody, physiotherapy, hairdressing, a well-stocked library, including daily newspapers, as well as full Wi-Fi. We have excellent support from the local medical practice in Upton – Upon- Severn. We have a range of daily activities that people are welcome to join as they wish. These include group exercises, Tai Chi, quizzes, and games. We are always open to further suggestions. We endeavour to meet the spiritual needs of our residents and welcome people of all faiths.
